- → A committee has to be formed to structure PTA properly.

- → Weekly / fortnightly attendance along with committee details and events schedule has to be send to parents via SMS.
- → College should have a tie-up with atleast 5 Psychologist for solving the problems of students.
- → In order to get accurate details copy of Aadhaar Card / Passport of parents has to be taken at the time of admission.
- → Google class room has to be used wherever convenient.
- → Usage of reference has to be increased.
- → Case studies has to be used as much as possible.
- → IQAC should identify 5 specific areas where NAAC is concentrating and should direct the efforts in those areas so as to get automatically prepared for NAAC.
- → Rules of University / NAAC has to be used as a yardstick to improve / enforce new innovative techniques.
- → CS / IT faculties have already stopped ordering textbook in order to focus on reference books.

- → A vision based on NAAC / Autonomy has to be prepared and followed.
- → Mr. Bimal Mehta agreed to provide seed fund to Mr. Ajay Sharma (student) for the development of software for an NGO.
- → In EDC, students with keen interest in entrepreneurship should be identified and groomed.
- → Campus to Corporate has to be restructured properly.
- → Mentor meeting report / committee report will be send to IQAC members.
- → Sponsorship for infrastructure has to be invited.
- → College can increase its revenue by starting evening courses or conducting online GATT / ITG / Banking exams.
- → Safety audit of women has to be done.
